Judges' Retirement System of Illinois

## Legislation Affecting You

SB3199 was passed during the final days of the 93rd General Assembly and signed into law by the Governor.

This bill allows a retired judge to be employed as either a legal counsel in the Office of the Governor or as Chief Deputy Attorney General without forfeiture, diminishment, suspension or any other impairment to their pension benefits solely by virtue of this service.

In order to take advantage of this provision, the retired judge has to sign an election not to participate in the State Employees' Retirement System at the commencement of this employment.

On the right is the election form that needs to be completed and filed with the Judges' Retirement System prior to July 1, 2005 for any judge who may seek the above positions after their retirement.
